From Town Road in Hanley take the B5049 (Chell Street) towards Smallthorne. After about 800m turn left into the car park.

Courses: 1 hour score using permanent course controls. Helpers on hand

Wednesday only will have a special adult course (45 mins) going into the nearby streets as well as the park (10 points per control)

Map: 1:5000 scale on waterproof paper will be provided but must be returned on the day. OR Download your own map free of charge from website www.britishorienteering.org.uk

Terrain: Hilly parkland with mixed woodlands, multiple tracks and paths surrounding a lake

Times: starts from 6.00 TO 7.30
